Thank you for purchasing a Honeywell 30 Series Network Video Recorder. The NVR uses HTTPS, a secure communication protocol that verifies the identities of visited websites and servers and encrypts data exchanged between the client and the server.

When you log in to the NVR web client for the first time, some browsers may display a warning that the connection is not private/secure. To access the web client, you must install a Honeywell-signed security certificate.

The installation of the security certificate involves three sets of steps:

- Logging in
- Downloading the root certificate
- Installing the root certificate

Logging in

Before logging in, make sure you have finished the initial setup of your network vidoe recorder. You can refer to NVR Quick Installation Guide or NVR Quick Networking Guide for more information.




Open your browser and enter the NVR's IP address in the address bar.



If you are using Chrome, a message appears warning that the connection is not private. Click Advanced.




Click Proceed to 192.168.1.108 (unsafe).
