The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) and the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) have reviewed your request dated November 22, 2000, and received December 4, 2000. This request was for an extension of approvals TC-13F-284, TC-13F-285, TC-13F-286, TC-13F-287, TC-13F-319 and TC-13F-463 to add three new hood style facepieces, a size small part number 968005, a size medium part number 968006, and a size large part number 968007, for use with the Survivair Panther/Cougar/Lo Pro series SCBA/SAR.

This extension of approval is granted. Approval is granted for English language only on all documentation. It is the manufacturer's responsibility to correctly translate materials desired in languages other than English.

The diskette enclosed with this letter contains the final respirator approval label for this submission. The cautions and limitations which apply to these approvals are on the approval labels. 
