PROTECTIVE BOOT

Honeywell offers the following rubber protective boot for use with the EDA10A Enterprise tablet:

• EDA10A-RB-0

The protective boot can be used with an EDA10A tablet with the Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK) attached.





Attach the Protective Boot

1. Insert the computer into the top of the boot and press down evenly.



2. Verify that the mobile computer fits securely in the protective boot.



Remove Protective Boot

Note: The protective boot does not need to be removed for battery replacement or charging with a compatible base (see page 2).

Routinely inspect the protective boot for damage, and replace if needed.

- 1. Hold the unit on both sides with the screen facing toward you. Use your thumbs to apply even pressure to the upper lip of the boot.
- 2. Apply gentle pressure to the back of the unit to release the top of the unit from the boot.
- 3. Lift the unit up and out of the bottom of the boot.


CHAPTER 3

HAND STRAP

The EDA10A Rotating Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK) can be used with the EDA10A Enterprise tablet to allow one-handed operation. The rotating hand strap can be used with an EDA10A tablet with or without the Protective Boot (EDA10A-RB-0).

The hand strap allows the tablet to rotate 360 degrees.

Features



Out of the Box

Make sure that your shipping box contains the following:


- Rotating Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK)
- Five D-ring thumb screws

If any items are missing or appear damaged, contact your Customer Account Representative. Keep the original packaging in the event that you need to return the Rotating Hand Strap or if you want to store the hand strap while not in use.


Attach the Hand Strap

No tools are required to attach the hand strap.

The hand strap can be attached to the EDA10A tablet in two positions to accommodate different hand sizes. For larger hand sizes, attach the hand strap with the release straps at the top. For smaller hand sizes, attach the hand strap with the release straps at the bottom.



1. Align the holes in the hand strap with the holes on the back of the tablet.



2. Insert a D-ring thumb screw into each hole and hand tighten.

Remove Hand Strap


To remove the hand strap, unscrew the four D-ring thumb screws.

Scan Barcodes

While holding the tablet with the hand strap, the user can tap the rear touch key to scan barcodes.

By default, the touch key is turned off. The **Touch Key** setting must be turned on in **Settings > Honeywell Settings > Touch Key** or by swiping down from the top of the screen and tapping **Touch Key**.




Replace the Battery


You can replace the battery in the EDA10A tablet without removing the hand strap.

Refer to the *EDA10A User Guide* for more information on battery maintenance. The user guide can be downloaded at sps.honeywell.com.

1. Pull up the release straps then slide the straps out of the rings.



2. Fold the hand strap back to reveal the battery cover.



- 3. Move the D-rings off of the battery cover.
- 4. Lift and remove the battery cover.
- 5. Remove the battery and install the replacement battery.
- 6. Replace the battery cover.
- 7. After the battery is replaced, slide the straps back through the rings and fasten the release straps.




SINGLE CHARGING DOCK

The Single Charging Dock can be used to charge one mobile computer. The EDA10A-SC-R Single Charging Dock must be used with a tablet in a protective boot (EDA10A-RB-0) or with an adapter cup (EDA10A-ADC) inserted.

The tablet can be placed in the Charging Dock with the Rotating Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK) attached.

Out of the Box

Make sure that your shipping box contains these items:

- Single Charging Dock (EDA10A-SC-R)
- Convertible Adapter cup (EDA10A-ADC)
- USB charging cable
- 5V 2A power adapter and plugs for US, UK, AU, EU, IN
- Product documentation



Remove Adapter Cup

The Charging Dock ships with the Convertible Adapter Cup installed. The Adapter Cup must be removed to use the Charging Dock with a tablet in the Protective Boot.

To remove the Adapter Cup:

1. Pull the release latches and tip the adapter cup forward to release the latch.



2. Use two hands to lift the Adapter Cup out of the dock.

Connect Power

The single charging dock uses a power adapter available from Honeywell.


- 1. Insert the USB-C plug into the USB-C port on the back of the base.
- 2. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Note: Inadequate source current may lengthen the charge time or prevent the battery from charging if the terminal is drawing more current than supplied by the USB port.

Charge the Battery Pack

If the tablet is not in a protective boot, place the Adapter Cup (EDA10A-ADC) into the charger.

Insert the tablet into the Single Charging Dock (EDA10A-SC-R). Unit will not charge unless a battery is installed.


DISPLAY DOCK


An EDA10A-DB Display Dock allows an EDA10A Enterprise tablet to become a personal computer. A monitor can be connected by HDMI, and a keyboard, mouse, and audio can be connected through the dock via the USB ports. The dock also provides an Ethernet connection.

The EDA10A-DB Display Dock must be used with a tablet in a protective boot (EDA10A-RB) or with an Adapter Cup (EDA10A-ADC) inserted.

The tablet can be placed in the Display Dock with the Rotating Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK) attached.

Features





Note: The display dock supports USB direct connections only. The dock does not support USB hub connections, including keyboards with USB port(s).

- EDA10A Display Dock (EDA10A-DB)
- Convertible Adapter Cup (EDA10A-ADC)
- Power Supply and Power Cord (model dependent)
- Product documentation



Dock Connectors

Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12 VDC and 7 A. The power supply input rating is 100–240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10°C to 50°C (14°F to 122°F). The maximum output of the base is 5VDC/2A.

- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power jack on the back of the dock.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Connect to Monitor

Note: See Monitor Connections on page 23 for a list of approved connections.

- 1. Plug the HDMI cable into the dock.
- 2. Plug the other end of the HDMI cable into the monitor.

Connect to an Ethernet Network

- 1. Plug the Ethernet cable into the dock.
- 2. Place the computer in the dock.

Note: For advanced Ethernet settings, go to sps.honeywell.com for the EDA10A User Guide.

Connect to a USB Device

Note: See USB Devices on page 24 for a list of approved USB devices.

Note: The dock supports USB direct connections only. The dock does not support USB hub connections, including keyboards with USB port(s).

Plug the USB type A cable into a USB port on the dock.



Status	Description
Constant Green	The dock is connected through HDMI.
Off	The dock is not connected or lost connection through HDMI.

Insert Computer into the Dock

If the tablet is not in a protective boot, place the Adapter Cup (EDA10A-ADC) into the charger.

Insert the tablet into the Display Dock (EDA10A-DB). Unit will not charge unless a battery is installed.



Configure the Display Dock Settings

You can configure the parameters on the computer for the Display Dock using the Display Dock app.

Set Display Dock Settings

The Display Dock Settings app is available from the all apps menu under Settings.

- 1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen to access all apps.
- 2. Select Settings > Honeywell Settings > Display Dock.

Set Monitor Settings

- 1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen to access all apps.
- 2. Tap Settings > Honeywell Settings > Display Dock.
- 3. Choose one of the following options to set the view:
 - Tap System portrait screen, to have the computer stay in portrait view.
 - Tap **System landscape screen**, to have the computer stay in landscape view.
- 4. To set the system resolution, tap **Resolution** and choose one of the available options.
- 5. To set the density, tap **Density** and choose one of the following options:
 - 160
 - 240
 - 320
 - 400
- 6. Select **Reduce backlight** to dim the device's back light when a display is connected.

Set Peripheral Settings

- 1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen to access all apps.
- 2. Tap Settings > Honeywell Settings > Display Dock.
- 3. To set the right mouse button to the back key, tap **Right mouse button** to toggle the feature on or off.

Set Mode Settings

The Display Dock provides three mode settings. In Primary and Mirror mode, the display on the monitor plugged into the dock is the same as what is on the screen of the mobile computer. In Desktop mode, the display looks and behaves like a desktop workstation, so for example, users can have multiple apps open simultaneously on the desktop.

Note: Availability of the Desktop Mode setting depends on the software version installed on the device.

Note: The Display Mode cannot be changed while the mobile computer is in the Display Dock.

- 1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen to access all apps.
- 2. Tap Settings > Honeywell Settings > Display Dock.
- 3. To set the external monitor mode:
 - Select Primary Mode to automatically adjust as configured in settings
 - Select Mirror mode to match the terminal's settings.
 - Select **Desktop Mode** to allow the mobile computer to function like a desktop workstation. The mobile device can be used as a second, separate display while in the Display Dock.
- 4. If Desktop Mode is selected, restart the mobile computer. The mobile computer must be restarted for the setting to take effect.

You may need to clean the dock to keep it in good working order. Clean the dock as often as needed for the environment in which you are using the dock with a dry, soft cloth.



The Quad Bay Charging Base can be used to charge one to four mobile computers. The EDA10A-CB Quad Bay Charging Dock must be used with a tablet in a protective boot (EDA10A-RB-0) or with an adapter cup (EDA10A-ADC) inserted.

The tablet can be placed in the Charging Base with the Rotating Hand Strap (EDA10A-HS-1PK) attached.


Connect Power



Remove the battery from the mobile computer. Insert the battery into one of the battery slots and press down.



Remove the Battery Pack

Use the tab on the battery to lift it up and remove it from the battery charger.

VEHICLE DOCK

Honeywell offers the following vehicle dock to securely fasten an EDA10A tablet in a moving vehicle:

• Vehicle Dock (EDA10A-VD)

The vehicle dock must be used with an EDA10A tablet inserted in the protective boot (EDA10A-RB-0).

A hand strap and stylus can remain attached to the tablet when it is inserted in the vehicle dock. The stylus must be attached in the upper right corner.





- Product documentation

If any items are missing or appear damaged, contact your Customer Account Representative. Keep the original packaging in the event that you need to return the Vehicle Dock or if you want to store the Vehicle Dock while not in use.

Features





Install the Vehicle Dock

The vehicle dock is compatible with a RAM® 4-hole AMPS mounting plate or 75mm x 75mm VESA pattern base.

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for attaching the RAM mounting plates.

Connect Power

The EDA10A-VD vehicle dock provides charging capabilities through a USB-A cable. The USB cable is for charging only and cannot be used for data transfer.


Charging is 5VDC@2A. The operating temperature is -20° C to 50° C (-4° F to 122° F).

To connect power, insert the USB-A plug into the power supply.


Insert/Remove the Tablet

The EDA10A tablet must be in the protective boot before installing it in the vehicle dock.

1. Hold the release latch in the middle and lift it straight up.



2. Insert the tablet into the dock. Ensure the tablet is fully seated in the dock.



To remove the tablet, pull the release latch up then lift the tablet out of the dock.



VESA Mount

The EDA10A-MNT-VS is a VESA adapter plate that is installed directly onto the tablet. Use the VESA plate to secure the tablet to a stand or wall mount.



- VESA Mounting Plate (EDA10A-MNT-VS)
- Ten (10) M3X5.5 mounting screws

Installing the VESA Plate

To attach the VESA plate to the tablet, insert the M3x5.5 screws into the tablet mounting holes.


MOUNT THE DOCK

Mount a Dock

You can mount an EDA10A charging dock or display dock on a flat, horizontal surface such as a desktop or workbench with an optional DIN rail.

Mounting hardware required:

- DIN rail
- 3/16-inch diameter x 5/8-inch long pan head screw
- 1/2-inch OD x 7/32-inch ID x 3/64-inch thick washer
- 3/16-inch diameter nut
- 1. Slide the DIN rail into the slot on the bottom of the charging dock.
- 2. Secure the DIN rail to the flat surface with the hardware.
