
After you open the shipping carton containing the product(s), take the following steps:


- Check for damage during shipment. Report damage immediately to the carrier who delivered the carton.


Before installing a modular accessory, remove the expansion port cover from the scanner as well as the presentation base, if installed.


Remove the Expansion Port Cover

WALL AND POS MOUNTS


Both the Genesis XP wall mount (STND-07R07) and the POS mount (STND-02F07) provide the flexibility of either a removable scanner or a fixed scanner.

The POS mount also includes a powerful magnet that can be used on the metal surface of a point-of-sale terminal.

Features

Note: The wall and POS mounts are shipped with the components assembled.


POS Mount STND-02F07 Magnet Magnet Mount Adapter Cube POS Mount



Warning: The strong magnet in the base of the POS mount may interfere with personal electronics.

Install the Mount

1. Pull the cube assembly away from the mount adapter to release the magnet.




2. Remove the screw at the top of the cube and set it aside.



3. Separate the cube and the mount.




4. If using the magnet in the POS mount, place the mount against a metal surface then skip to Step 8.



5. To secure the mount with screws, use a pen and the mount holes as guidance to mark where to drill.





6. Drill holes in the mounting surface. For non-wooden surfaces, insert the plastic anchors into the holes.




7. Position the mount over the holes and secure it with the self-tapping screws.





- 8. Remove the expansion port cover and base from the scanner (see page 2).
- 9. Attach the mount adapter to the scanner using the two screws provided with the kit.




Note: Both mounts can be set up so that a scanner is removable (proceed to Step 10) or fixed in place (skip to Step 11).


- 10. For a flexible assembly that allows you to remove and then reattach the scanner using the magnet in the cube:
 - a. Position the cube on the mount.



b. Secure the cube to the wall mount with the screw that was previously removed in Step 2.





c. Attach the scanner to the mount using the magnet in the cube. The installation is now complete.




11. To fix the scanner in place:


a. Attach the cube to the mount adapter using the medium-sized screw provided.



b. Connect the unit assembly to the mount.




CHAPTER 3

VERTICAL STAND


The Genesis XP vertical stand (STND-18R06) allows the flexibility of a mounted yet movable scanner for counter or tabletop use.

Install the Vertical Stand

- 1. Remove the expansion port cover and base from the scanner (see page 2).
- 2. Optional: thread the scanner cable through the channel in the stand.
