


UNIVERSAL DOCK ETHERNET HOME BASE

An Ethernet Home Base is a charge/communication base for one mobile computer and one spare battery. The CW45-EB-UVN Universal Dock Ethernet Home Base also has an Ethernet connector as well as a USB client connector (Type B).

Universal Dock bases have removable device cups that can be replaced. (See Universal Dock Cups on page 21.) The CW45-EB-UVN also has a removable battery cup. (See Replace the Battery Cup on page 6.)


Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12VDC and 3A. The power supply input rating is 90-264 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F). The maximum output of the base is 5VDC/2A.


- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the base.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

Insert computer into the CW45-EB-UVN. Unit will not charge unless a battery is installed.



You can also insert a battery pack into the Ethernet Home Base for charging by lining up the tabs on the battery with the slot on the base.




Replace the Battery Cup

The CW45-EB-UVN has a replaceable battery cup (CW45-UPC-BATTHEB).




Caution: Keep the base flat to avoid dropping the battery cup.


- 1. Remove all cables to allow clear access to the latch.
- 2. While holding the battery cup latch to the right, lift the back of the cup.




3. Release the latch and lift the old cup out of the base.



4. Insert the new cup tilted slightly towards the front of the base.



5. While holding the latch to the right, push the back of the cup into the base until it snaps in.



6. Release the latch.


UNIVERSAL DOCK CHARGE BASE AND ETHERNET BASE

The CW45-CB-UVN Universal Dock Charge Base charges up to four mobile computers.

The Ethernet (Net) Base CW45-NB-UVN base charges up to four mobile computers and functions as both a charge and communication base, with two RJ45 Ethernet Connectors.

Universal Dock bases have removable cups that can be replaced. (See Universal Dock Cups on page 21.)


Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12V/7A. The power supply input rating is 100-240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F).

- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the base.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

Insert device with battery installed into the charge base.

UNIVERSAL DOCK 5-BAY CHARGE BASES


The Universal Dock Five-Bay Charge Base CW45-5CB-UVN provides the flexibility of charging five units or four units and four batteries with a four-bay CW45 battery charger cup (CW45-UPC-QBC).


The Universal Dock Five-Bay Charge Base with 4-Bay 8675i Scanner Cup CW45-5CBS-UVN charges up to four CW45 devices and four 8675i scanners with a four-bay scanner cup (UCP4-SCN10).

Universal Dock bases have removable cups that can be replaced. (See Universal Dock Cups on page 21.)



Insert a Charger



Note: These instructions show the CW45-UPC-QBC Quad Battery Charger Cup for illustrative purposes. However, these same steps can be used to insert the Four-Bay 8675i Scanner Cup (UCP4-SCN10).

1. Insert the charger cup tilted slightly to the left of the base.



2. Press the latch release button as you push the charger cup down until it snaps in.



Connect Power


Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12V/8.3A. The power supply input rating is 100–240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is 0 °C to 45 °C (32 °F to 113 °F).

- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the base.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

Insert a device with a battery installed into the 5-Bay Charge Base.

When using the CW45 Quad Battery Charger cup, insert a battery into the battery charger by lining up the tabs on the battery with the slot in the charger.



QUAD BATTERY CHARGER

The Quad Battery Charger charges up to four CW45 batteries. The battery charger also has a removable battery cup. (See Replace the QBC Battery Cup on page 19.)


Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12V/3A. The power supply input rating is 100-240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is 0 $^{\circ}$ C to 45 $^{\circ}$ C (32 $^{\circ}$ F to 113 $^{\circ}$ F).

- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the base.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery

Insert one to four battery packs into the charger by lining up the tabs on the battery with the slot in the charger.






Replace the QBC Battery Cup

The CW45 QBC has a replaceable battery cup (CW45-UPC-QBC).


1. Push the release latch in.




2. Tilt the latch side of the cup upwards.




3. Lift the old cup out of the base.




Replacing a Universal Cup


1. Push the latch towards the front of the base.




2. Tilt the back of the cup upwards.




3. Lift the old cup out of the base.

MOUNT A CHARGING DOCK

Mount a Charging Dock


You can mount CW45 docks and chargers on a flat, horizontal surface such as a desktop or workbench using an optional DIN rail.

Mounting hardware required:


- DIN rail
- 3/16-inch diameter x 5/8-inch long pan head screw
- 1/2-inch OD x 7/32-inch ID x 3/64-inch thick washer
- 3/16-inch diameter nut

Note: A Charge Base is shown in the instructions below for illustration purposes. The mounting steps are the same for all CW45 docks and chargers.

1. Slide the DIN rail into the slot on the bottom.



2. Secure the DIN rail to the flat surface with the hardware.





CW45 TO 8675I CABLE ADAPTER

The CW45-8675-CBL adapter connects a CW45 to an 8675i Rugged Compact Wearable Scanner (sold separately). The cable provides power and communications between the CW45 and the scanner. For more information about 8675i scanners, refer to the 8675i product page at sps.honeywell.com.







CW45 USB 2.0 TYPE-C ADAPTER

The CW45 USB 2.0 Type-C Adapter enables conventional USB 2.0 charging at 5V and USB communication via connection to a USB Type-C cable (sold separately).

Note: The adapter is not compatible with USB-C variable voltage/amperage in new USB-C standard chargers.



Note: If the connected CW45 is inserted into a charging base, communication will be interrupted.

Connect Power

You can charge your unit via the CW45 USB 2.0 Type-C Adapter and a USB cable by connecting the assembly to a USB port on a host device or with the optional 5VDC/2A wall charger (p/n 50130570-001).

The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F).

Charge the Battery Pack

Charge from a USB Port on a Host Device

Charging the battery through a USB port takes more time than direct charging using the optional wall charger.


- 1. Connect the CW45-SN-CNV adapter to a CW45 computer.
- 2. Connect the CW45-SN-CNV adapter to a USB-A to USB-C cable such as the Honeywell CBL-500-120-S00-05.
- 3. Connect the USB cable to your personal computer.

Note: Inadequate source current may lengthen the charge time or prevent the battery from charging if the terminal is drawing more current than supplied by the USB port.

Charge with Optional Wall Charger (50130570-001)

Use only a UL listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 5VDC/2A with the device.

- 1. Slide the regional plug adapter into the wall charger.
- 2. Connect a USB cable to the wall charger.
- 3. Plug the wall charger into an AC power outlet.



- 4. Connect the CW45-SN-CNV adapter to the USB cable.
- 5. Connect the CW45-SN-CNV adapter to a CW45 computer.



KEYPAD

The CW45-KPD keypad is an optional extended keyboard with 20 multi-function buttons/shift keys for manual data entry.



Installing the Keypad


A CW45 computer with an attached keypad can be worn on either the left or right arm. However, the CW45-KPD can only be connected to the I/O connector on the right-hand side of the CW45.

Note: Ensure your device's firmware is up to date before installing a keypad. For more information about firmware updates, refer to the CW45 User Guide, which is available on the product page at sps.honeywell.com.

- 1. Remove the mount assembly from the CW45 by pressing the release latch. (For more information, refer to the CW45 Quick Start Guide available at sps.honeywell.com.)
- 2. Attach the keypad to the right-hand I/O connector of the CW45. Ensure that the mounting holes are lined up on the device and the keypad.



3. Secure the keypad in place with the screws provided.



4. Reattach the mount assembly.

Note: If the CW45 with attached keypad is inserted into a charging base, communication with the keypad will be interrupted.

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
